PSC 125—Physical Science: The Physical World

2 lect., 2 lab, 3 cr.

Topics are drawn from the fields of Physics, Chemistry, Geology, Meteorology and Astronomy with emphasis on how the scientific method guides the various disciplines. Laboratory work enhances and develops the lecture material. (GE 2) Prerequisite: Tested into MAT 101 or completed MAT 020

PSC 140—Physical Science: The Environment

2 lect., 2 lab, 3 cr.

A study of the interaction between the physical environment and man. Concepts in natural sciences are introduced as a basis for discussion of current environmental issues. Local environmental issues are discussed. (GE 2)

Prerequisite: Tested into MAT 101 or completed MAT 020
